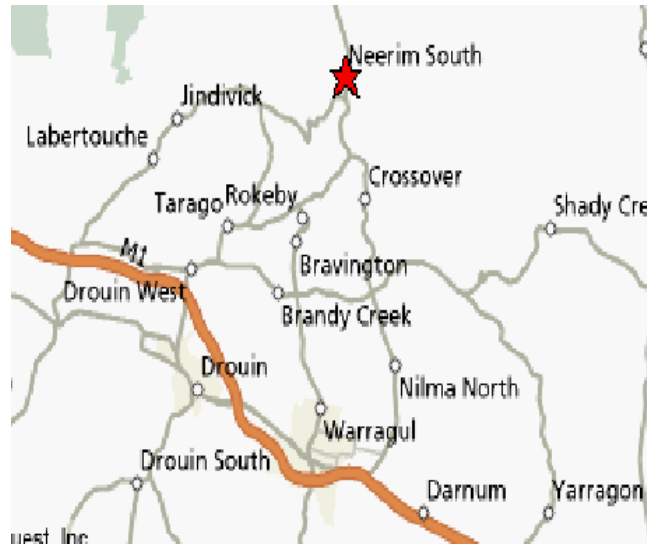

OUR SERVICES

The Neerim District Health Service is a Bush Nursing Hospital that has provided quality services to the local and surrounding communities since 1914.



We are a small private hospital that provides a diverse array of visiting surgeons, medical specialist, physiotherapist, massage therapist and our own general practitioners and medical registrar (all claimable through medicare.)

The hospital enjoys close links with many other health care providers, to facilitate the best delivery of holistic health care. Our staff are committed to provide quality patient care in a happy safe environment.

We offer an Interim Care service for clients waiting for placement and Respite Care for up to two weeks.

SURGERY & OUTPATIENTS

A new state-of-the-art ,purpose built, operating theatre is a recent addition to the hospital. Operating services include general surgery, plastic surgery, endoscopy, urology and ophthalmology, specialising in cataract surgery.

The hospital also provides outpatient services in conjunction with the local Medical Practitioners. Visiting specialists and allied health providers. Services such as pathology, dressings, ECGs, Maternal Health Nurse, Podiatry and Physiotherapy are available.



TARAGO VIEWS AGED CARE

Tarago Views Aged Care provides 30 High Care nursing home beds in a homely safe environment. Clients in the unit are provided with private or double rooms, some with ensuite facilities—and adequate space for personal belonging.

Nursing Care is provided by qualified staff on a 24 hour basis.

Clients also have access to allied health services such as Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Pathology, Podiatry and Dieticians. A Diversional Therapist is available 4 days a week and Hairdresser once a week.

A planned Respite Bed is available for up to two weeks.
